# **Uniform**

# Just a reminder that as from September 2018 Jade green is the colour of our jumpers and cardigans

All shirts, blouses or polo shirts must be in white or navy with or without the school logo (easy to get on and off for the youngest children).

All jumpers/cardigans/sweatshirts must be **Jade Green** with or without the school logo.

All socks should preferably be in navy or grey or black.

All tights, long socks and leggings must be navy or grey or black

Boys' trousers must be navy or grey or black.

Girls' trousers must be navy or grey or black.

Shorts must be navy, grey or black which take a crease

Skirts/pinafore dresses must be in navy or grey or black.

Summer dresses must be in blue or blue "gingham" print.

### **PE Kit**

### KS1 and KS2

On your child's PE Day children are expected to come to school in the morning in their **PE Kit.** This is:

- Plain White T-Shirt
- Navy Blue or Black Shorts
- Black or Dark Blue Jogging Bottoms
- School Jumper or Cardigan

Plain Black Trainers to be worn. (Compulsory from Sept 2018)

A PE timetable will be sent home every half –term so you know what date/days your child will have PE.

\*If children are taking part in sports clubs at lunchtime or after school e.g. Running Club on a different day to their PE Day they need to come in their Full School Uniform with Sports Kit in a bag to change into.

# **Sports News**

Thank you to all parents who support us in helping children to participate and enjoy Extracurricular Sport at Steeton Primary School. This year's highlights include:

- 5 children qualified in cross country to represent Bradford in the West Yorkshire Cross Country Competition in Temple Newsam
- Alice O'Sullivan won the silver medal and went on to represent West Yorkshire in the National Championships at Loughborough University
- In Netball we came second in the league winning all but 1 match in the league and qualified to represent Keighley in the Bradford School Games.
- Individual pupils placed 1st and 2nd in the Oakbank Athletics Competition
- Year 3/4 boys qualified and represented Keighley (Oakbank Cluster) for 7 a side football at Hanson Secondary School for Bradford School Games.

- Year 6 semi-finalists in tag rugby.
- Qualified for the Bradford School Games to represent Keighley in Tennis
- Dance team came second in Keighley in dance off competition at Oakbank Secondary School.

A high profile of sport at Steeton Primary School and a 'can do' attitude towards sport in school and children excited and engaged in competitive sport has resulted in us gaining Achieving School Games Mark Gold Award for this academic year with 80% of KS2 engaged in extra-curricular sport
