Dear Parents and Carers,

Another week has flown by and we are very pleased with the general behaviour of the children around school. Absence and Attendance

Attendance for the year so far is 96.3%, which is excellent considering the circumstances we are in.

School Uniform

The children are all looking smart in their uniforms but please could I send a reminder that footwear. It should be suitable for running around in the playground to minimise trips and falls at playtime.

Also please pay particular attention to the section of our uniform policy concerning jewellery, head wear and hair accessories:

- Nail varnish and jewellry are not appropriate for school and are not permitted.
- If a child has pierced ears **only** plain studs or very small /quick release safety earrings are acceptable.
- Earrings must be removed or taped for safety in P.E.
- ALL head wear and ALL hair accessories must be in school colours or dark colours.
- Watches are allowed but must be small and not cause any form of distraction, e.g., detachable parts, sounds or large covers/accessory parts.

Parents Evenings

We do intend to have our usual Parent Consultation after half term, albeit in a Covid secure way. We will be offering parents either a 10 minute phone call or a zoom call with the class teacher. Further details will be sent out next week.

Science Week

The week beginning 19th October (The last week of term) will be a whole school Science Week. This will be a Science Enquiry week where the children have many hands on practical activities. This is in order to develop their ability to think independently and raise questions about working scientifically and the knowledge and skills that it brings.

Forest School

Now that everyone is settled back into school, we are going to restart Forest School sessions for each class. These will be over two days with half a class at a time (approx. 15 children) spending a whole day in the Forest School. The first sessions will run next week for Year 1/2 and your child's Class Teacher will ping you out more details. We are excited about being able to use this special resource once again, to enhance the children's educational experience.
