Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a strange week in school without our Yr 5/6 children and staff but as my message below says they have all been working very hard. ## **Absence and Attendance**

### Yr 5/6 Bubble Closure

Unfortunately, this week and next we have had to close the Yr5/6 'bubble' after consultation with the DFE and Public Health. I would like to say a big thank you to your children and you as parents for your support and cooperation in participating in the live zoom learning sessions. The attendance has been very pleasing and I hope next week will be at least as good. These methods are also a new experience for the teachers who are having to adapt quickly to the virtual teaching and are learning new techniques daily as they reflect on their teaching. They would like to thank you for understanding any technological hitches there may have been.

### Maintaining Changes to the School Day from January 2021

Thank you for the comments we have received through schoolping regarding the decision of the Governing Body to extend the current changes to the School Day to February half-term. We will be collating and considering the responses next week with feedback and any actions taken relayed to you as soon as we can.

Below is a reminder, from the letter sent out, of the reason behind the decision to continue as we are next term.

When we made changes to the school day in order to reopen fully in September, we promised you that this would be until Christmas in the first instance and that we would then review it. Given that we are still in the midst of a Global Pandemic, a new

National Lockdown and the news from Mat Hancock on Monday that this may be extended beyond 2nd December or implementation of stricter Tier measures, we have had to make the review as a matter of urgency.

It is clear to us that we will still be unable to operate as we did Pre Covid and still provide the same levels of safety and curriculum opportunities. It is the decision of the Governing Body to continue with the school day and times as they are now, until February half term. As before, we will be constantly reviewing how we operate as a school in line with Government recommendations and the ongoing coronavirus situation.
