Attendance

Attendance since the 8th March is 96.2%, which is above National Average.

Reading For Pleasure

Next week is our Reading for Pleasure research week. This is going to be fun and exciting, with many different activities taking place over the week.

We will be looking at the children's reading habits and how they see themselves as readers. We will be thinking about our local communities and their reading habits. To support this, please make sure that you respond to the questionnaire which will be sent to you via Ping. Please do not feel that we are looking for a particular answer to the questions; this is absolutely not the case. We have all – as staff - answered a similar questionnaire and found that we have many different attitudes to reading in school – and not all are positive! The point of the survey is to establish a baseline from which we can build on and develop opportunities for our children.

The children will be making tasty treats and singing songs as well as enjoying hot chocolate and new books.

Please can you make sure that your child brings in their favourite book or story from home on Monday and that they keep it in school all week.

Support payments for parents/carers of pupils told to selfisolate due to bubble closures.

In the unfortunate event of a bubble closure the council has offered the following advice : If you are a parent/guardian of a child or young person who has been told to self-isolate you may be able to get a £500 self-isolation support payment.

You might be able to get the payment if you cannot work from home and need to take time off work to look after them.

The child must:

- be 15 or under, or 25 or under if they have an Education, Health and Care plan (EHC)
- live with you
- normally be at school or in childcare

have been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace or their school or childcare
provider

You'll need to meet the other eligibility criteria and you'll need evidence that your child has been told to self-isolate.

Any application must be received within 42 days of the start of your self-isolation period.
