This week, the Reading for Pleasure research week has been a great success. There has been a real buzz around school with children fully embracing the project with excitement, enjoyment and a sense of purpose. Staff have also being analysing their own reading history, habits and knowledge and sharing these with the children.

Can I please ask that if you have not already responded to the Reading Survey, which was sent to you via Ping, could you make sure it is completed. Can I just remind you that do not feel that we are looking for a particular answer to the questions; this is absolutely not the case. We have all – as staff - answered a similar questionnaire and found that we have many different attitudes to reading in school – and not all are positive! The point of the survey is to establish a baseline from which we can build on and develop opportunities for our children.

After this week, we will use the findings from the research to fully integrate a plan to continue and develop a culture of Reading for Pleasure in our school community.

I would like to particularly thank Miss Bingham and Miss Redman for all the hard work they have put in to organise what has been a really enjoyable week for all.

Talking about the Underwear Rule with Children

In the past during Safeguarding weeks, we have had visitors from the NSPCC who deliver assemblies and workshops in School. These involve sessions about staying safe. Unfortunately, due to Covid restrictions this has not been possible over the last year.

One of their sessions that has been delivered in school before is around 'The Underwear Rule'. This a simple way for Teachers and parents to help keep children safe from sexual abuse – without using scary words or even mentioning sex. The guide uses the rules of PANTS to teach children that their body belongs to them and them alone. I am going to play the 'PANTS' SONG to the whole school in a Zoom assembly on Monday Morning.
