Covid 19- Arrangements for the Holiday from Friday 28th May - Sunday 13th June 2021

If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms **within 48 hours** of being in school, that is between 12:15pm on Friday the 28th May (3:00pm if in Enrichment) and 12:15pm on Sunday the 30th May (3:00pm if in Enrichment), **you must contact school by email or text** to inform us.

Please can you include an image of the positive test confirmation.

This is because we have to work with Public Health England who will use the information to advise the school who we will have to contact regarding self-isolation.

If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms **more than 48 hours since** being in school, that is after 12:15pm on Sunday 30th May (3:00pm if in Enrichment) the **school should be contacted by email or text** so we can advise which day after the holiday your child can return. This will not result in anybody in your child's bubble having to self-isolate.

Also, in this case you should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

IMPORTANT: Car Parking and Safeguarding

Yesterday at home time Market Street was very busy and some cars were causing a hazzard and safeguarding issue by the way they were parked. Both blocking the pavement which resulted in children, adults and people pushing pushchairs having to walk in the road.
