


# **Steeton Primary School**



**WELCOME TO LKS2 2022/23** 



## What happens at the start and end of the school day?

All of the children in Year 3 and 4 come into school via the park gate between 8:30am and 8:45am. They are greeted by members of staff. Children line up with their class mates in 3 different lines depending on the class they are in. At 8:45am class teachers meet the children outside and bring the children into their building. Once inside children go into their cloakroom and hang up their coats and bags. Children then go into their classroom and are registered.

At the end of the school day children collect their coats and bags from the cloakroom and line up outside. Parent and carers and after school carers meet the children at the park gate at 3pm and children are let out by a member of staff once they have seen the person collecting the child.

## What does my child need to bring each day to school?

School provides all stationary and books and everything else your child needs to learn with in school.

Your child needs to come in school uniform most days including Magic Mondays. Your child should come in their PE kit on the days outlined in the PE timetable that is sent to you each term.

#### What will this year be like?

We follow the National Curriculum and your child will study many different subjects throughout the week/year. Including: maths, english, science, art and design, design technology, computing, history, geography, RE, PSHE, PE, music and Year 4 children will have swimming. We link history, geography, art and design and design technology through topic based work in afternoons and the other subjects are taught as stand alone subjects. 'Science Week' is always the first week of each half term. As well as studying subjects we follow our FOREST principles to guide children to be the best learner they can be.

Morning playtime is 10:30-10:50am and all of KS2 play out together. Lunchtime for LKS2 children is 12-12:55pm.

#### Will my child receive homework?

All children are expected to read at home everyday. Class teachers will also give children homework on a Friday which will need to be handed in on the following Friday. This may be Maths, Literacy or a piece of work that is linked to what they are learning in class.
