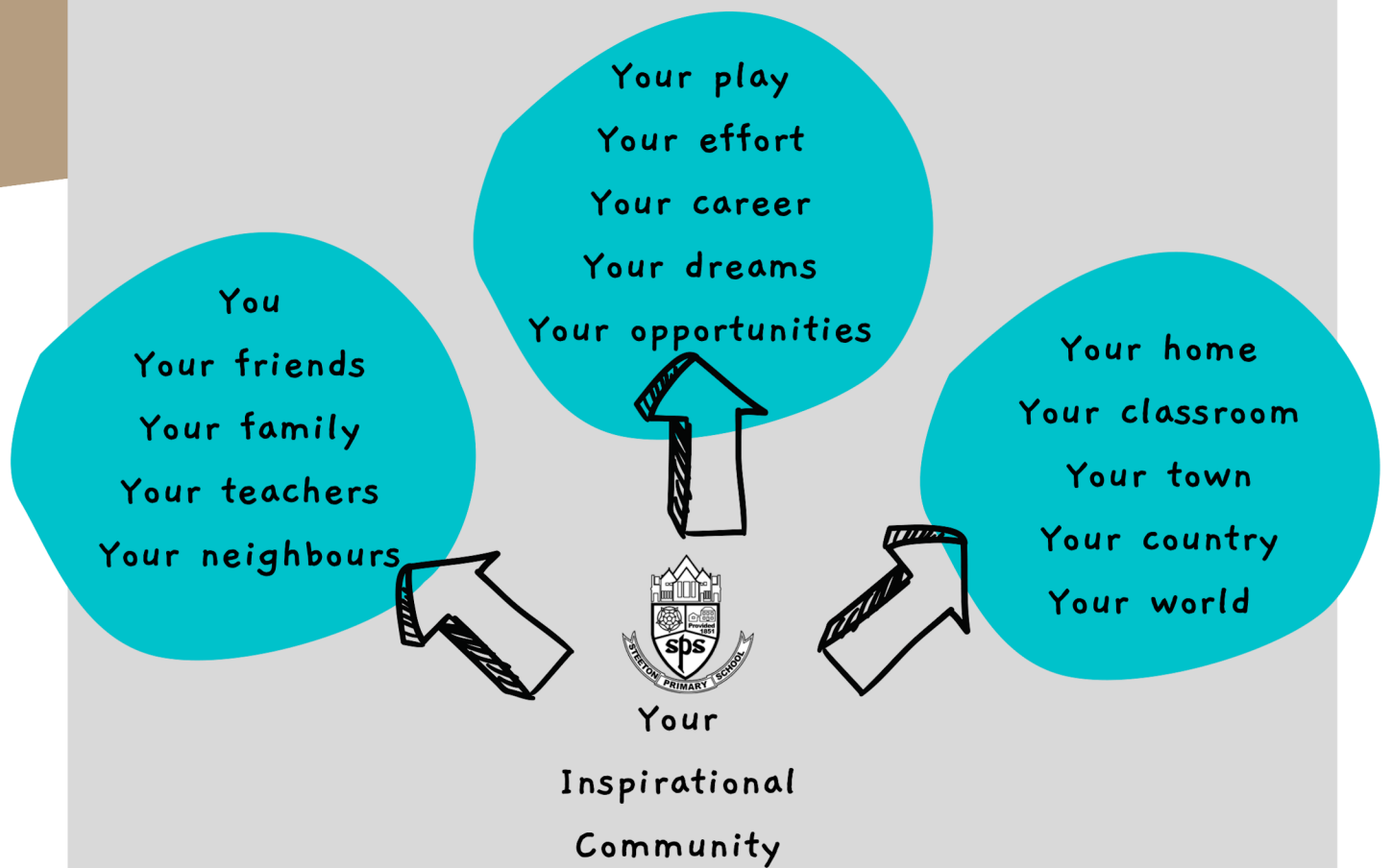


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Our Vision

In the Early Years Foundation Stage at Steeton, we focus on how children learn; developing strong and effective learning behaviours to establish a solid foundation for their time at school.



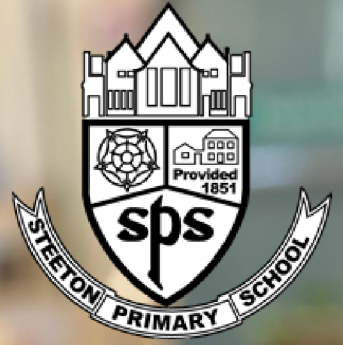
Our skilled staff teach children to read systematically and effectively using Read, Write, Inc. phonics.



We encourage early writing through Greg Bottrill's 'Drawing Club,' which leads children into Writing for Pleasure in Key Stage 1.



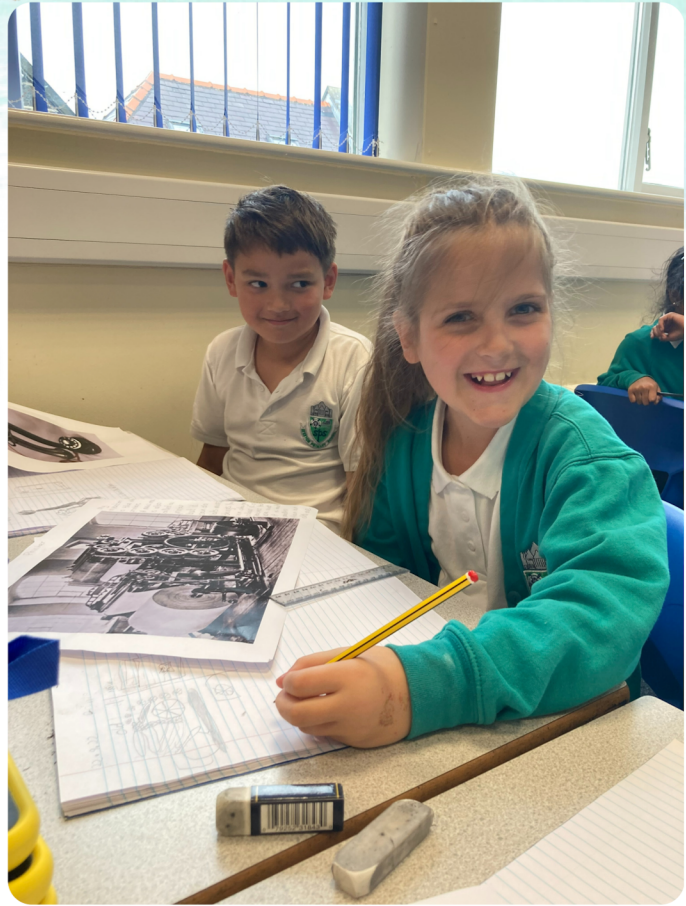
Curriculum vision

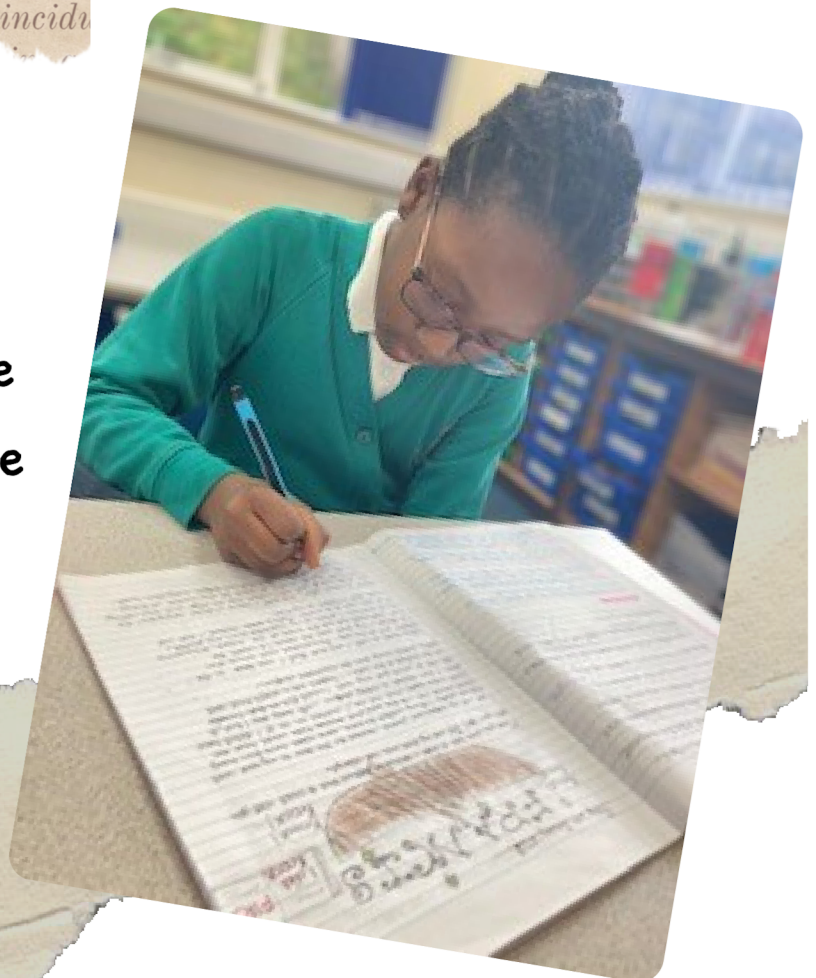
Reading and Writing for Pleasure

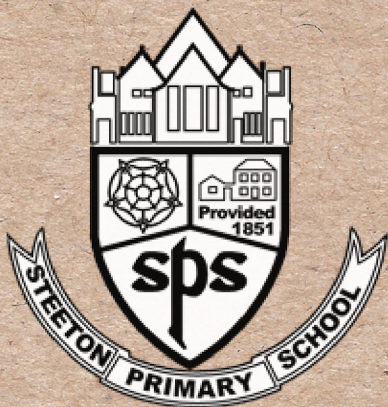
