## Our adventures at Steeton Primary School this week...

- In assembly on Monday, we thought about things we are good at. So many children - and staff - at school can speak more than 1 language and we often overlook this. Most of us studied a language at school, some carried it into higher education, but few continue throughout their life. To be able to understand and/or speak more than 1 language is a gift and a talent; proven to improve critical thinking and promote brain power. More to come on this throughout the year.
- The road safety team have been in school this week and all children enjoyed their workshops. It was great to see practical sessions, with groups of children out and about on the streets around school learning how to cross safely etc. Given that school is surrounded by roads - many of them very busy - these are crucial skills that will keep everybody safe.
- Miss Bibi spoke to children this week about our Mood Monsters. These live in each classroom and encourage children to recognise and acknowledge their feelings and emotions each day when they arrive in school. She was impressed with the way children spoke about their feelings and that they know how to regulate themselves or who to speak to if they need to.
- Next week it is parents' consultation evenings on Monday and Wednesday. Please make sure that you have booked your session on Ping. With only 12 weeks of school remaining this year, it is important that you know how to support your child to maximise progress.
- Thank you to everyone who has completed the surveys via Ping this week. We are working with Bradford Council to establish demand for wraparound childcare and your views will help to give a clear picture. With regard to 32.5 hours of school a week and adding 15 minutes to each school day, we appreciate that everyone's view will differ around where to place the extra time. Once we have completed the consultation, we will inform you as soon as possible about the changes from September.

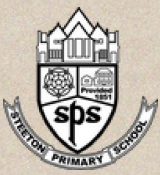

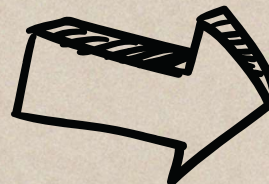
Unfortunately, these are really expensive and even though our aim of £5,000 seems like a lot of money, it actually won't go that far towards what we want.
