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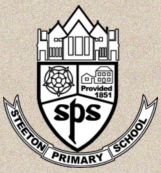

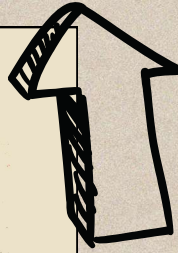

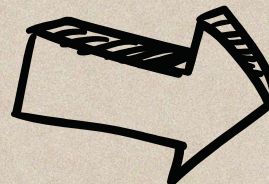
Unfortunately, these are really expensive and even though our aim of £5,000 seems like a lot of money, it actually won't go that far towards what we want.
