## Our adventures at Steeton Primary School this week ...



- · As we move into May and summertime, please ensure your child is wearing sun cream and brings a cap to cover their head. They are outside for prolonged periods in the sunshine each day.












From Monday, children will be able to order a packed lunch 'grab bag' from school to eat outside as an alternative to a hot school lunch.
