## Our adventures at Steeton Primary School this week ...


- We have had an extremely busy week this week!

- · Thank you to all parents who responded to the parents consultation questionnaire. Everyone who responded was overwhelmingly positive about their experiences and felt that it is useful.












Children can order a packed lunch 'grab bag' from school to eat outside as an alternative to a hot school lunch.

We are trying to raise enough money to make the surfaces of our playground - the walls and floors stimulating and more exciting, and maybe add more features like the pirate ship which everyone can play


Unfortunately, these are really expensive and even though our aim of £5,000 seems like a lot of money, it actually won't go that far towards what we want.
