Music

This half term we will be answering the Big Question 'How can humans minimise the threats to habitats?'

We will complete a study into music as an aspect of British history and the significant individuals that have shaped this type of entertainment.

We will describe connections and contrasts between aspects of history, people and events studied through learning about the different styles of music

We will sequence several events on a timeline while studying Music through the ages starting at the I940's.

English / Reading

Rowan and Elder class will be participating in our 'Writing for Pleasure scheme'. Our first stimulus of the term will be Chitty Chitty Bang Bang.

Our class texts will be alternated throughout the year between the different classes. Each class will read one text per half term. We will be reading 'The Wild Robot', 'The Creakers', 'Brand new boy', 'When the mountains roared', 'Marvellous Granny Jinks' and 'The nothing to see here hotel'.

Science

Our topic is Sound.

We will be learning the subject knowledge objectives Below through a combination of scientific enquiry.

- identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating
- recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear
- find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it
- find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it
- recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases
