Summer 2-Sport-Euro 2024

Topic

Next half term our topic will be sport and we will be focussing on the Euro 2024 football competition as this will be taking place during June and July. We will be trying to answer the big question "What do you know about the Euros?"

Children will learn about the history of the competition, it's location this year, teams/players/kits, stadiums, rules/sportsmanship and of course, the trophy.

Children will have a football tournament within the key stage to see which team can be crowned Steeton Champions!

Although the women's Euro football competition is not until next year we will also be looking at the women's championship too.

Magic Monday

Next half term there will be a focus on Design Technology in our Magic Monday sessions and we will be looking specifically at levers. Children will look for examples of different types of levers around the school and will then design and make a lever that controls a footballer scoring a goal.



Children will, as always in DT, follow the process of first designing, then

making and finally evaluating their product.

English / Reading

Padlet—we have now started using Padlet in class to enable children to make book reviews that are published onto a page that can be accessed by children in school and at home. You should have received a QR code for your child's class to enable them to access this.

Oak class will be continuing to build on their independent writing during their drawing club lessons.

Maple and Willow classes will be using a clip from the film Chitty Chitty Bang Bang as their stimulus for writing next half term.

Handwriting lessons have started across school and children are enjoying learning about water/sun/boat letters (ask your child to explain!)

Science

Our first week back will be a science week. Children will be learning more about materials. This time however the focus will be on the suitability of materials for the job they do eg Why do we choose glass to make windows? What is the best material to make a pillow? Etc.

Children will have chance to carry out some comparative tests to find out which material would be best to make a raincoat and which material is best to protect the 3 little pigs from a hungry wolf.
