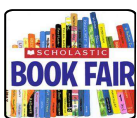


Maths at Steeton

We use White Rose Maths and LBQ at school. LBQ is 'learn by questions' and children access it on their iPads (from Y2). You can help develop maths skills at home by practising times tables, playing counting games, talking about and using money, telling the time and subitising. Subitising is the ability to see and count numbers instantly without counting 1 by 1. This could be recognising 4 ducks on a pond, or knowing there are 4 ducks because there are 2 groups of 2 without actually counting...
