Marvellous Mountains

Our History and Geography lessons are taking students on an exciting journey to explore the wonders of mountains and volcanoes! They'll learn how mountains are formed, discover different types, and explore famous expeditions to some of the world's highest peaks. Using world maps and atlases, children will locate the largest mountains and uncover patterns of where volcanoes are found.

Magic Monday

This half term, our Art lessons are inspired by the vibrant work of Andy Warhol, as students explore his iconic style through their own creative projects. The children will experiment with a variety of techniques to create striking images of Mount Vesuvius, using mediums such as block printing, oil pastels, inks, paints, and mono printing.



English

This half term, we're excited to introduce a new set of Reading for Pleasure books in our classrooms!

In the upcoming weeks, the children will be working on a writing task inspired by a short film called *Alma*. This eerie and suspenseful clip will serve as a creative prompt, encouraging the students to craft their own pieces of suspense writing. They will focus on building tension, creating mystery, and developing a sense of intrigue in their stories.

Science

This half term, our Science week topic is Animals, including Humans. We will explore the human circulatory system, identifying and naming its main parts, while learning about the essential functions of the heart, blood vessels, and blood. They'll also examine how diet, exercise, drugs, and lifestyle choices affect the way our bodies work. Plus, children will discover how nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans, gaining a deeper under standing of the incredible processes that keep us alive and healthy.
