| <p>Children's phonic knowledge has been reassessed and they may be reading books from a different colour band next half term. They may also be in a different phonics group with a different teacher. Don't worry if your child hasn't moved to a different group, everyone is progressing but they may not be quite ready for the next level just yet. Please support us by watching the sound videos sent home each week and by reading the phonics/ book bag books with your child each week. Also please ensure you send book bags in every day so that children always have their books to hand if we want to read with them/change their books.</p> <p>We will continue with our Curious Quests in our English lessons where Professor Klunk will be sending us a new text to work on each week.</p> | <p>In the first week back after the holidays it will be our science week across school. We are studying the unit "Animals including Humans." As part of this we will be looking at how people and animals grow and change during their lifetime. We will look at lifecycles of different animals too. We will also learn about the basic needs of humans and animals for survival. After this we will learn about hygiene, the different food groups, healthy eating and exercise.</p> <p>Please could you email a picture of your child as a baby to your child's teacher so we can see how humans change over time.</p> |
