Little People Big Dreams

Our topic for this half term is "Little People, Big Dreams". This unit of work gives the children the opportunity to learn about

Kings, Queens, Princes, Princesses, Knights, dragons, palaces and castles. We will learn about our capital city 'London', in relation to the members of our Royal family who live there now, or lived there in the past. We will learn about how and why castles were built and what it was like to live inside them. We will think about what we would do if we were a King or Queen for a day.

Expressive Arts and Design

.As Artists, we will use mixed media and different techniques. We will paint castles by using bricks to print castles in the style of Paul Klee. We will learn how to draw castles and make crowns, sceptres, swords and shields.







Literacy / Early Reading

Phonics—Read Write Inc

We will be learning and consolidating Set 2 sounds. We will continue to learn how to blend words orally and blend sounds to read simple words, captions and sentences.

Drawing Club

We will continue with Drawing Club! Texts as a stimulus for Drawina Club will be: The Queens Hat by Steve Antony. The Kings Pants by Nicholas Allan Mr Benn and the Red Knight The Frog Prince Bella the Tower Bridge Cat by Tee Dobinson We will retell parts of the stories. We will draw pictures and write simple sentences.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

As Historians, we will look at the life and work of the Royal family and the impact that they have had on us and the world. We will look at their contribution to society and how things have changed by looking at the Royals as children and as they are today.

As Geographers we will find out about our capital city. We will see where it is on a map and look at some famous London landmarks.

As Scientists, we will have the opportunity to find out about materials and construction. We will learn how we can choose appropriate materials to join different materials and look at what works and what doesn't. We will attempt to make bridges and other landmarks.
