This week's adventures...

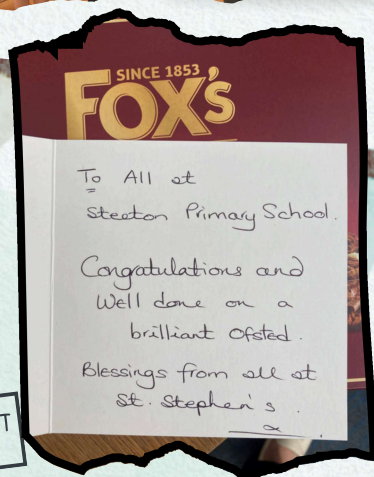
