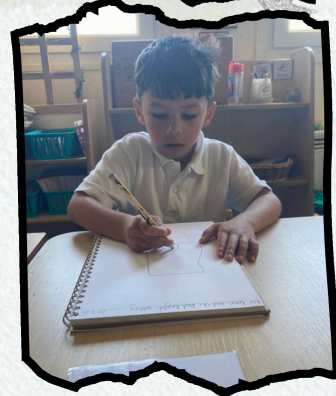
Oak class are enjoying their new classroom - thanks to parents and carers who have supported with the change. Mrs Foulds and Mrs King are very pleased!
