Topic

Our topic for the last half term of this academic year will be "TV Over Time." We will be finding out all about who invented TV, how it works (at a basic level!) and how it has changed since it was invented. We will be looking at popular children's TV programmes from the 1950's up until now and trying to answer the big question "Was children's TV better in the past?" We will make model TV's and create our own TV programmes using a stop animation app on the ipads.

Our final trip of the year will be to Lytham St Annes for a day of fun on the beach on Wednesday 25th June—a letter will follow shortly.

It's hard to believe another year is nearly over!

Magic Monday

We will be continuing our work on puppets this half term in our Magic Monday lessons due to the short last half term and several missed Mondays.

Children will be working on their DT skills to design a superhero puppet, then make templates and use them to make an outfit for their puppet. They will also be making and evaluating their final puppet design to see if they are happy with the outcome.



English / Reading

We continue to work on a variety of reading and grammar skills in our Curious Quest (English) lessons. The inventor of the Curious Quests Greg-Botrill will be visiting school later this half term-hopefully some of the children will get to meet him

Phonics sessions are ongoing and the children were reassessed just before the holidays. Please continue to support your child with their phonics and reading books that they should be bringing home each week. If your child is not bringing home books please ask them why not and mention it to your child's class teacher.

Science

Our Science focus for the first week back has been Seasonal Changes. Children have been looking at how weather and day length change throughout the year and why. They have looked at how animals and plants adapt to the different seasons too. We have worked on the enquiry skills of: observing changes over time, pattern seeking, sorting and classifying, research and comparative testing.

We have been testing the best material to protect us during a Spring shower and observing how shadows change throughout the day.
