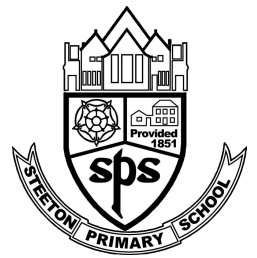

## Summer 2 Holidays through time



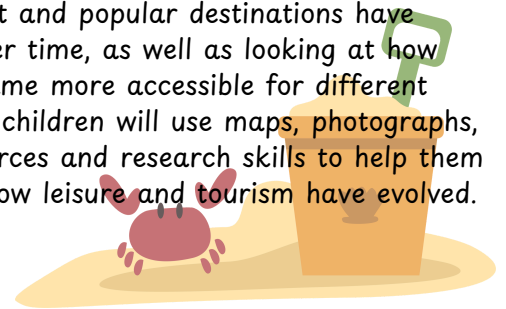
### Magic Monday - Slider Card

We will be focusing on DT this half term and designing and making a product using a new skill - creating a moving slider mechanism. Linking to our holidays topic, the children will be designing a holiday-themed postcard scene where a black and white image transforms into colour as the slider moves. The children will spend time carefully planning and designing their final product, developing their drawing and design skills, including creating cross-sectional diagrams of their ideas. Once completed, the children will evaluate their products and carry out market research to gather feedback from others.



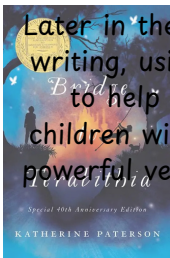
### Holidays Through Time

In History and Geography this half term, our topic will be Holidays Through Time. The children will explore how holidays and travel have changed throughout British history, comparing seaside holidays from the Victorian era to the modern-day trips and experiences we enjoy today. We will investigate how transport, accommodation, entertainment and popular destinations have developed over time, as well as looking at how holidays became more accessible for different families. The children will use maps, photographs, historical sources and research skills to help them understand how leisure and tourism have evolved.



### English - Bridge to Terabithia

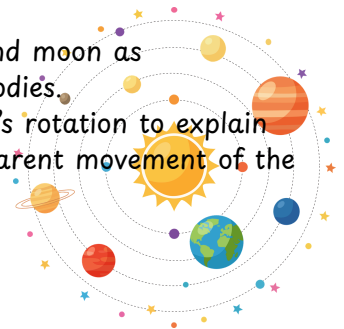
In English this half term, Year 6 will be using the magical story of Bridge to Terabithia as inspiration for some exciting pieces of writing. The children will explore the mysterious forest setting and use ambitious vocabulary, figurative language and descriptive techniques to create their own vivid setting descriptions. Later in the unit, we will be focusing on suspense writing, using dramatic moments from the story to help build tension and atmosphere. The children will experiment with sentence structure, powerful verbs and cliff-hanger moments to keep their reader hooked!



### Science - Earth and Space

Children will:

- Describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets relative to the movement of the sun.
- Describe the movement of the moon in relation to the Earth.
- Describe the sun earth and moon as approximately spherical bodies.
- Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.
